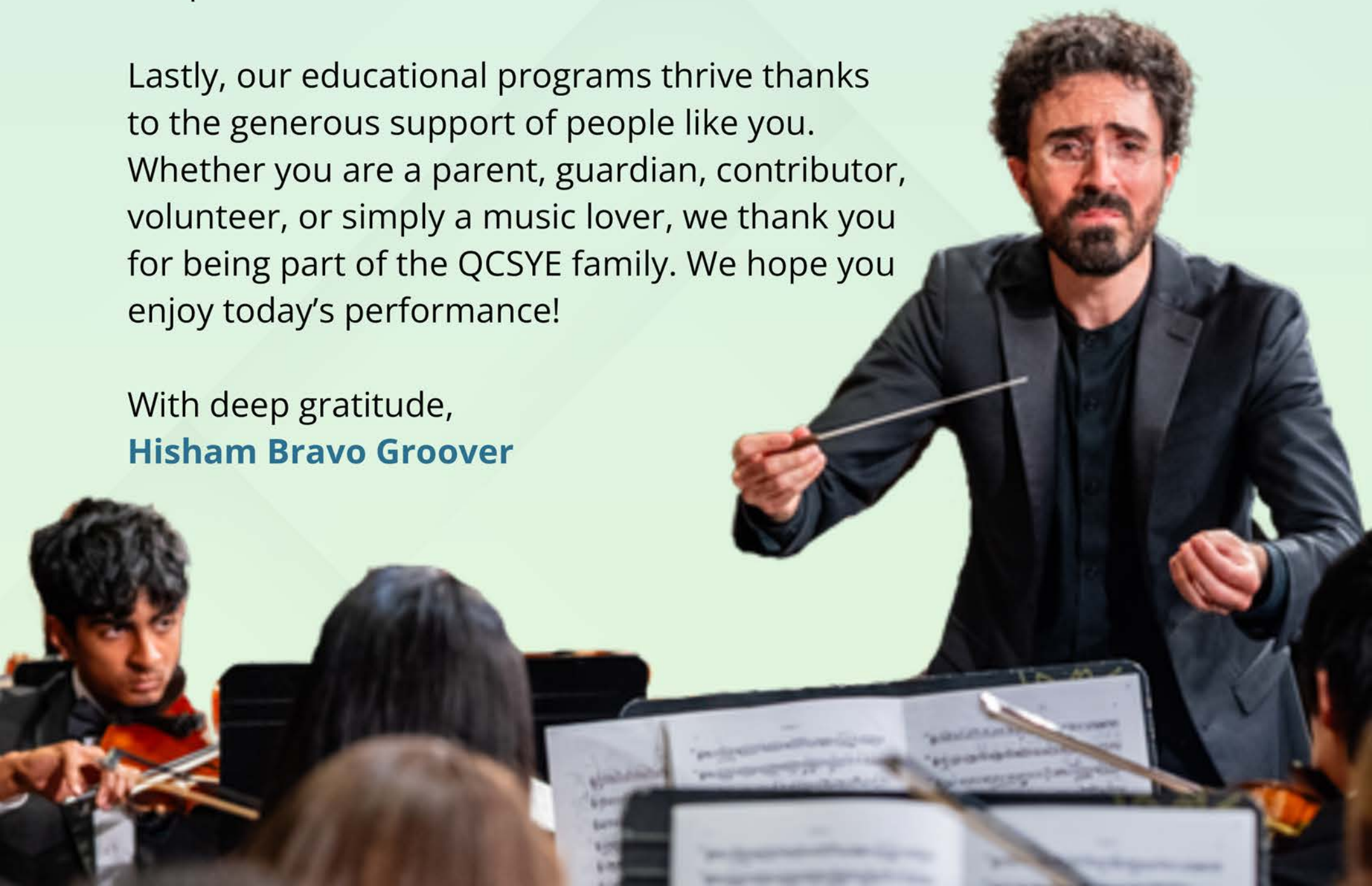
*Dear Families and Friends of the QCSYE,*

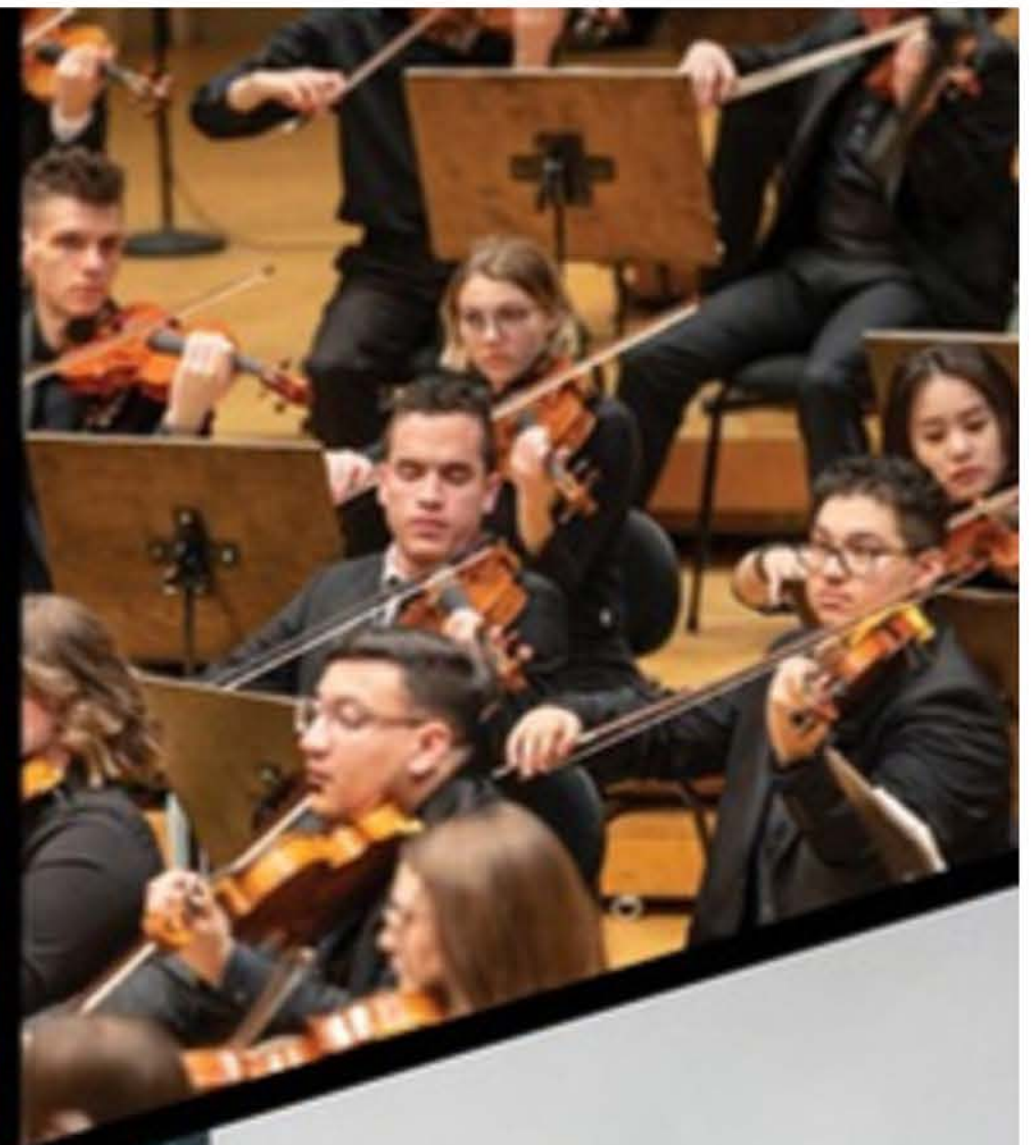

# CONDUCTOR BIOS

---



## MARK RUSSELL SMITH

Mark Russell Smith is in his 18th season as Music Director and Conductor of the Quad City Symphony Orchestra, where his artistic leadership has brought renewed vision and world-class artistry to the region. Under his direction, the orchestra has welcomed celebrated soloists such as Yo-Yo Ma, Midori, Joshua Bell, André Watts, and Garrick Ohlsson, while deepening its commitment to community engagement. The ensemble's dedication to serving audiences throughout the COVID-19 pandemic further solidified its role—as well as Smith's—as a cultural pillar of the Quad Cities.

A passionate educator, Smith serves as Artistic Director of Orchestral Activities at the University of Minnesota and Artistic Director of the Greater Twin Cities Youth Symphonies. His major artistic initiatives include the University of Minnesota's Britten Peace Project and the St. Matthew Passion project, both of which united American and German students for international performances and cross-cultural study. He has also collaborated with the Joffrey Ballet, conducting Stravinsky's *Rite of Spring* in a landmark centennial exploration.

Smith's guest conducting career includes engagements with leading American orchestras such as the Minnesota Orchestra, St. Louis Symphony, Houston Symphony, and St. Paul Chamber Orchestra, as well as international appearances across Europe, Asia, and the Americas. He is also an active opera conductor, earning acclaim for productions including Mozart's *The Magic Flute*.

A strong advocate for contemporary music, Smith has led numerous premieres and innovative new music initiatives, including the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra's Engine 408 series and the cross-cultural project *Hún Qiáo (Bridge of Souls)* with Yo-Yo Ma.

A graduate of the Juilliard School and the Curtis Institute of Music, Smith began conducting as a teenager in Phoenix. He lives in Minneapolis with his wife, Minnesota Orchestra horn player Ellen Dinwiddie Smith, and their two sons.

Hisham Bravo Groover is serving his second season as Assistant Conductor of the Quad City Symphony Orchestra and Music Director of the Quad City Symphony Youth Ensembles. He is also Assistant Professor of Music and Director of Orchestral Studies at Augustana College.

Before moving to the Quad Cities, Hisham lived in Minnesota where he served as Artistic Director and Principal Conductor of the St. Cloud Symphony Orchestra, Philharmonic Conductor of the Greater Twin Cities Youth Symphonies (GTCYS), Music Director and Conductor of the Buffalo Community Orchestra, and Assistant Conductor of the University of Minnesota Symphony Orchestra and Opera Theatre. Additional experiences include roles as Associate Conductor of the Denver Philharmonic Orchestra (CO), Assistant Conductor of the Arapahoe Philharmonic (CO), Assistant Conductor of the Lamont Symphony Orchestra and Opera Theatre (CO), and Conductor of the University of Iowa Chamber Orchestra (IA).

Hisham displays impressive versatility in his concerts, equally at ease with pops and educational programs as he is with masterworks. He has also conducted and assisted in numerous opera productions, including Britten's *The Turn of the Screw*, Mozart's *Don Giovanni*, and Strauss Jr.'s *Die Fledermaus*. Thoughtful in his programming, Hisham aims to create concerts that resonate with modern audiences. In 2024, he conducted a program that integrated the music of Hildegard von Bingen, Steve Reich, and Charles Ives with Mozart's *Requiem*.

Recently, Hisham has competed in two international conducting competitions. In 2023, he was invited to the 1st International Ferenc Fricsay Conducting Competition in Szeged, Hungary. In 2022, he was a semi-finalist in the Princess Astrid International Music Competition in Trondheim, Norway. Hisham is also a violinist and has studied with several pedagogues, including Michel Boris Zaitzeff, Ching-Yi Lin, and Mark Rush. As a conductor, he has had the privilege to study with Leonid Grin, Kevin Noe, William LaRue Jones, and his principal mentor, Mark Russell Smith.



## Keira Cromwell

Keira Cromwell is a 16-year-old cellist from Iowa City and a junior at Laurel Springs Academy. She began her studies at the Preucil School of Music at age three and has been an active participant in the Preucil Orchestra and Cello Choir for many years. She currently serves as principal cellist of the Quad City Youth Symphony Orchestra.

Keira has been fortunate to perform in a variety of settings and has earned opportunities through concerto competitions with the Central Iowa Symphony, Fort Dodge Area Symphony, Muscatine Symphony, Ottumwa Symphony, and the Quad Cities Symphony Orchestra. She is also a Pan-American Music Awards winner, which included a solo performance at Carnegie Hall, and a recent recipient of the Iowa City Music Study Club Scholarship Award.

Her musical development has been shaped by programs such as the Ascent Music Cello Festival, Interlochen, and the International Cello Institute. She also studies piano and flute, contributes volunteer performances in the community, and mentors younger musicians through the Preucil work-study program. Keira studies cello under Laura Shaw at the Preucil School of Music and is further mentored by Hannah Holman.

Outside of music, Keira trains in foil fencing at the Iowa City Fencing Center and has qualified for USA Fencing Nationals multiple times.



## Zack Morton

Mr. Morton is Director of Instrumental Music at Moline High School and has held the position since 2013. A graduate of the University of Iowa, Mr. Morton has an undergraduate degree in Trombone Performance and Music Education. From 2006-2007, he accepted a position abroad as Bass Trombonist with the Hofer Symphoniker in Hof, Germany. After performing for a year in Hof, and two months touring with the Berlin-based Philharmonie Der Nationen, he returned to the University of Iowa to finish his degree in music education. While in Iowa City, Mr. Morton was assistant conductor of the New Horizons Senior Band and brass choir for two years. After returning to the Quad Cities, Mr. Morton became active as a Bass Trombone performer, performing with the Quad City Symphony Orchestra, the South-East Iowa Symphony Orchestra, and the Quad City Brass Quintet. His tenure at Moline High School includes expanding the musical offerings of the instrumental program, including adding a third concert band, a second orchestra, and a chamber orchestra.



## Elizabeth Lundine

Elizabeth Lundine is an orchestra director in the Davenport Community School District. She is currently the Associate Director of Orchestras at North High School, where she primarily directs the 9th Grade Orchestra. She also directs the 4th, 5th, and 6th Grade Orchestras at Harrison Elementary School. Outside of orchestra, Elizabeth is a co-head coach for the Boys and Girls Cross Country team at North High School. Elizabeth is originally from the Chicago suburbs and moved to the Quad Cities to attend Augustana College, where she graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Music Education. At Augustana, she studied primarily with Dr. Susan Stone and Dr. Daniel Culver. Since graduating, she has performed with several orchestras, string quartets, and pit orchestras in the Quad Cities. In her free time, Elizabeth enjoys running marathons, racing local 5k's/10k's, and cheering on the Augustana Cross Country/Track teams.



## Kim Busic

Kim Busic currently serves as the Violin/Viola Teaching Artist for the Quad City Symphony Orchestra, faculty member at St. Ambrose University, and section violinist for the Quad City Symphony Orchestra. She earned a Bachelor of Music from Butler University and a Masters of Music from Boston Conservatory at Berklee. She has studied with Larry Shapiro, Cornelius Chiu, and Bruce Molsky (old time fiddle) and has participated in masterclasses by Brooklyn Rider, Eroica Trio, Ralph Fielding, Katie Lansdale, and Gerhard Schulz. Additionally, she has studied viola under Richard Auldon Clark and cello under Dr. William Grubb. Anthony Hernandez resides in Geneseo as a private lessons teacher, freelance teacher and low brass performer. He taught band at Geneseo Middle School and High School from 2006-2020.
